
# TELE-EDUCATION FOR ASD

## WHAT IS IT?

Tele-education for ASD uses video technology to share knowledge from specialists to educators about Autism Spectrum Disorders.

#### **Education Sessions:**

- Weekly or biweekly
- Include educators across multiple locations
- Last for 60-minutes, across 8-10 sessions
- Include didactics and case presentations
- Focus on information and supports for students with ASD
- Provide troubleshooting for educators around issues related to ASD in the classroom
- Aim to help educators operate with increased independence as their skills and self-efficacy grow

#### **Educator Development and Retention**
